Therapy Dog Level 1 (Beginners)

For Dogs 3 Months & older. Fee - \$75

Therapy Dog Level 2 (Advanced)

Completion of Level I, Dogs must know basic commands, and have instructor pre-approval. Fee - \$75

Therapy Dog Level 3 (Certification)

Completion of Level II and Instructor pre-approval required. \$85 fee includes CGC/Therapy Dog testing fee.

Pre-registration IS required. Classes are limited. Verification of vet care required.

Classes are typically held on Tuesdays

Classes offered will be based on requests made via submitting an application and required paperwork.

We use positive motivational methods of training such as food, praise, and toys. The Therapy Dog Level 1 is a basic manners class which includes Sit, Down, Stay, Come, Heel, Wait, Automatic Sits while heeling, and fun stuff like the tunnel, tire jump, and walking through cones. This class will also introduce our canine friends to wheelchairs, walkers, crutches, and other items needed in preparation for pet therapy work.

Obedience is something every dog should be taught. Obedience training makes a dog much more fun to be around and you'll find yourself wanting to take your dog to more places.

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Rules & Regulations for Training Class

1. Pre-registration is required. Mail application, vet care verification, and the signed and dated Rules & Regulations for Training Class, along with your check made out to Suzanne Vening (no less than 21 days before the first day of class) to:

2. Dogs must be transported to and from class in a safe manner. Dogs will not be allowed to ride loose in the back of a truck or in a vehicle that would allow the dog to jump out, nor transported in any other area than might not allow enough air.
3. Please be on time for class. Class begins on time every class night.
4. You must attend at least 6 of the classes in order to graduate.
5. Dogs should come to class with a proper collar and lead. If you are not sure, please talk with your instructor. The preferred training lead will be a 6 foot leather lead; please do not bring leashes made of chain or rope, nor retractable leashes.
6. No dog will be allowed off leash before, during, or after class. Please make sure you keep a firm hold of your leash.
7. If your dog relieves himself, please clean up after your dog. We appreciate being able to use the locations we have to conduct these classes, so please help us show that by cleaning up after your dog.
8. Please keep your dog under control at all times. If you are having difficulty doing so, please see your instructor after class. No dog will be allowed to threaten or lunge at other dogs or students without proper instruction.
9. Please be respectful of the students and dogs in class; maintain a safe 6 foot distance between you and the other dogs.
10. Please do not bring dogs not registered in class to the training site without prior approval from the instructor.
11. **You must train at home to get results!!!! ;-)**
12. No smoking at the training site. No alcoholic beverage consumed before the class or at the training site.
13. Please do not leave your dog unattended.
14. Please bring soft treats for your dog such as diced hot dogs or string cheese for class. Please bring water and a bowl for your dog, and water for yourself as well.
15. I understand some therapy dog certifying groups do not require special classes in order to have a dog evaluated; many simply require that the dog be one year of age. These groups leave how well prepared and socialized the dog is for pet therapy work to the discretion of the owner. Other certifying groups do require special therapy dog class(es) in addition to several hours of supervised pet therapy visitation.
16. Students 18 years or younger must be accompanied to each class by a parent or legal guardian. No exceptions.
17. It is the instructor's sole discretion to determine whether a dog is qualified to graduate.

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What to bring to class each week

1. A buckle or quick release collar. Please bring a choke or pinch collar if you have already purchased one for your dog.
2. A 6' obedience lead. Please do not bring chain leads. Lead needs to be leather or durable fabric.
3. Please bring lots of your dog's favorite treats. These should be special treats used only in training and should be soft to the touch. Dog's can eat these much more quickly than a hard biscuit type treat. Suggestions include, but are not limited to: small bits of hotdogs, small bits of string cheese.
4. A toy motivator if your dog has a favorite toy (such as a ball, squeaky toy, frisbee, etc).
5. Water and bowl for your dog AND water for you!
6. A hungry dog! You may want to delay your dog's meal before class. This will make the dog's attention much more acute!
7. Bags for clean-up after your dog! As responsible pet owners, we always clean up after our pets.
8. A positive attitude and trust in your dog!
